Bozeman designer Isaac Arms creates unique modern furniture

**THE FRENCH** had Le Corbusier.

Montana has Isaac Arms.

Arms, a Bozeman designer, creates functional, modern art that just happens to be furniture. After receiving a bachelor's degree from Montana State University, Arms went on to earn a Master of Fine arts from the University of Wisconsin/Madison.

His work combines wood and steel to create sleek looks found usually in urban centers like Seattle or L.A.

But they're now being found in Montana.

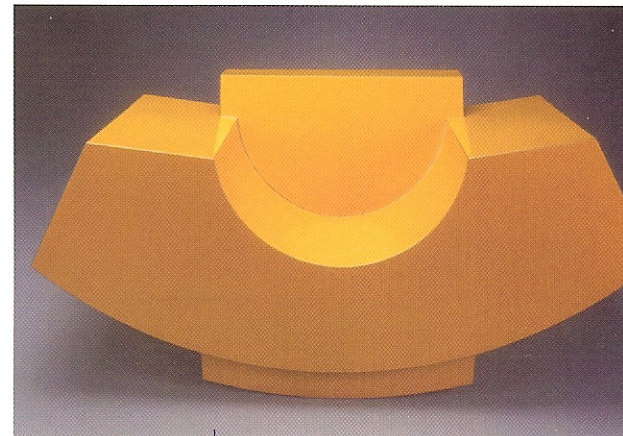
"The chair, above all other furniture forms, is a three dimensional object in the purist sense," Arms says.

Transferring cardboard templates to plate steel, Arms cuts, welds, and grinds the pieces together, transforming what were two-dimensional shapes into an object rich with three dimensions. "For me, calculating, observing and participating in this metamorphic progression is the most rewarding aspect of the creative process," Arms says.
